THE WOOD BADGE PLAN

WOOD BADGE training is the highest level training program for all Adult Scout Leaders, including Cub Scout, Boy Scout, Varsity Scout and Venturing leaders, Council and District leaders and Scout professionals. WOOD BADGE teaches how to be a better leader and how to lead groups to effectively plan projects and achieve objectives. The first part of WOOD BADGE is practical training which takes place in a camp setting where leadership skills are learned and practiced. Wood Badge training does not cover outdoor skills. The second part of WOOD BADGE is application of the leadership skills to 5 goals self-selected by the participant. Participants earn their "beads" after successfully completing both the practical training and their 5 goals.

Arrival for the first day of each weekend is 7 a.m. Departure on the last day of each weekend is 5 p.m. Attendance is required at both three-day weekends.

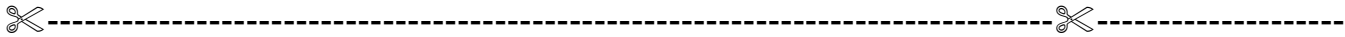
